Reflection - The Most Beautiful Act in the World Continued in Me

The holy sacrifice of the Mass – the greatest and most important event occurring every day in the life of the world. It was Fr. Pio (St Pio) who said that it would be easier for the world to survive without the sun than to do so without the Holy Mass. The Mass is the main source of God's grace. It is by grace through our faith in Jesus Christ, our personal Saviour that we are saved.

The Mass – A continuation of Christ's Sacrifice on Calvary. Christ is the blemish-free, perfect sacrifice (cf. Hebrews 9:14) on the cross for our sins which hurl offence at our holy God. He instituted it to continue His supreme act of love and salvation, to remind me of His sorrowful Passion that He underwent for me, the selfless love that He holds in His heart for me, to be a limitless source of grace for any need or problem in my daily life so that I may live life fully, to invite me to be part of His salvific action, for me to be in union with Him in His important mission for the world. What is my response to His invitation, His love?
