

Scripture nugget – Moral relativism and Religious indifferentism

I am the LORD, there is no other, there is no God besides Me. It is I who arm you, though you do not know Me (Isaiah 45:5).

We possess the absolute, unchanging truth in Jesus Christ and His Word. Jesus said to him, "I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me (John 14:6). An absolute truth does not need human endorsement or belief. It stands for eternity unchanged by time or circumstances. Everything passes away except God and His Word which include His teachings. Jesus said: Heaven and earth will pass away, but My Words will not pass away (Matthew 24:35). Thus, compared to other non-Bible based religions the doctrine of our faith in Jesus Christ is divine, absolute and true. Your Word is truth (John 17:17). Moral relativism dictates that there is no absolute right or wrong but that everything is relative. Situational Ethics is a derivative of moral relativism, and states that nothing is absolutely right or wrong but depends on the situation. Thus, this same fuzzy human thinking gives justification to premeditated killing such as abortion and euthanasia. Juxtaposed against the truths of our faith in Christ, moral relativism is exposed to be false. It is a poorly conceived human ideology undoubtedly inspired by the Enemy of our souls to appease the human ego, to trivialize sin and evil and to evade responsibility for wrong doings. It runs contrary to our faith which encourages us to acknowledge and confront our sins squarely and to seek repentance and forgiveness. If we acknowledge our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing (1 John 1:9).

I am the LORD, there is no other, there is no God besides me (Isaiah 45:5). Another related fuzzy human ideology is **religious indifferentism**. It undermines our true religion as it dictates that all religions are the same leading to the same end. It is obviously a falsehood inspired by the Evil One to lure unsuspecting souls away from the true path. Scripture tells us that there is only one true God. Even nature testifies to only one true God. If we analyze the genetic make-up of plants and animals we find a distinct pattern throughout the world. If we analyze the inanimate matter, we find they are made up of similar building blocks in the whole world. The signature of the one true God is in all He created, and this insight can be derived by right reason, logical thinking and a heart that is not opposed to God but which is open to receive the truth. St Paul warned the Corinthians not to have anything to do with idol worship because unknowingly the pagans are offering sacrifices to the demons. *No, I mean that what they sacrifice, [they sacrifice] to demons, not to God, and I do not want you to become participants with demons (1 Corinthians 10:20).*

CONVERSATION WITH JESUS: Precious Lord, I believe with my whole heart, whole mind and whole soul that there is only one, true God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit: three Persons in One God Who is over all and in all.
