

Scripture nugget -Our soul, our most precious possession

What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? (Mark 8:36).

How much is a soul worth? Every human being has a soul given by God at the moment of its conception in the womb. Thus, God dictates that human life starts at conception, not at birth. Our real enemies are Satan and the evil spirits that try to tempt us. With the help of God's grace, we are engaged in spiritual warfare till the last day of our life.

Humility, love, a sincere prayer life and an ardent desire to walk in Your footsteps and to fulfill God's will through the obedience of His Commandments serve as a good armor against Satan and his temptations.
